CLARIFICATION	<p>Arising from the briefing on the above held 7 August 2014, MCMC wishes to clarify that Paragraph 2.7 should read as follows and not as per the earlier issued Invitation to Register Interest bearing the mentioned reference. The earlier issued Appendix 6 is also NOT APPLICABLE.</p> <p>Registration of Interest deadline is extended to 12pm 21 August 2014 and Submission of Draft Plan deadline is extended to 12pm on 4 September 2014.</p> <p>2.7: The SKR1M to be set up shall meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) Technical requirements:<ul style="list-style-type: none">i. The entire infrastructure and connectivity where applicable, unless otherwise specified in this Invitation, shall be provided by the Licensees.

- ii. The Licensees shall ensure the access and end-to-end connectivity from the SCLC and comply with the interoperability and its related interconnection with the network facilities providers, network services providers, applications service providers and content applications service providers as may be applicable.

(b) Service requirements:

- i. The provision of bandwidth services.
- ii. The Licensees shall provide specific provisions or enter into agreement to facilitate and encourage usage of capacity and access at reasonable commercial market rate, to the network facilities providers (NFP), network services providers (NSP), applications service providers (ASP) and content applications service providers (CASP) as may be applicable. Should issues on rate arises, MCMC will intervene to remediate the matter.

(c) Financial requirements:

- i. For the avoidance of doubt, the SKR1M project shall be delivered as a Public Private Partnership (PPP). The financial resources of SKR1M shall be contributed from the Universal Service Provision (USP) Fund and from the Licensee's investment.

The Licensees shall demonstrate that they have strong credit backing and can directly or indirectly arrange successful financing for the provision of SKR1M.<li data-bbox="792 411 1437 806">iii. The Licensees shall clearly state its amount of investment from the total estimated project's cost and include in the draft of universal service plan all appropriate information including the capital expenditure (Capex) costs relating to the design, supply, delivery, install, test and commission of SKR1M.<li data-bbox="792 848 1437 1031">iv. The Licensees shall take necessary measures to ensure that the facilities and services of SKR1M are in operation for up to 20 years.
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
