COMMUNICATIONS AND MULTIMEDIA ACT 1998

VARIATION TO THE COMMISSION DIRECTION ON PROVISION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES UNDER THE REQUIRED APPLICATIONS SERVICES (DIRECTION NO. 1 OF 2010)

Direction No. 1 of 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 52, 193(2) and 194 of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 [Act 588], the Variation to the Ministerial Determination on the List of Required Applications Services (Determination No.1 of 2004), Determination No.2 of 2010 and the Ministerial Determination on Required Applications Services, Determination No.2 of 2005, the Commission issues the following direction:

Citation and Commencement

- 1. This direction may be cited as the Variation to the Commission Direction on Provision of Emergency Services under the Required Applications Services (Direction No. 1 of 2010), Direction No. 1 of 2018.
- 2. This Direction shall come into operation on the date of its registration.

Variation to paragraph 17

- 3. The Commission Direction on Provision of Emergency Services under the Required Applications Services, Direction No. 1 of 2010 ("principal Direction") is varied in paragraph 17:
 - (a) by substituting for the words "and public cellular services" the words "or public cellular services or both,";
 - (b) by deleting the word "those"; and
 - (c) by inserting after the words "suspended accounts" the words "at no charge".

Variation to paragraph 18

4. Paragraph 18 of the principle Direction is varied by inserting after the words "emergency calls" the words "at no charge".

Other provisions under the principal Direction

5. Save for the variations expressly provided in this Direction, all other provisions as contained in the principal Direction shall remain unchanged and continue to be in full force and effect.
