



## **Customs K2/ K8 Validation against STA Permit**



#### **Objective of the Validation**



To ensure important details in the permit **are** declared as per the approval given by the approving agencies


To control/ avoid **misused of the permits** for exporting strategic items

To control/ ensure the destination of the strategic items exported is as per approval given

To control/ ensure that exports of strategic items from Malaysia are safe and within the STA 2010 law



#### Validation Process




# Strategic Trade Act: Changes at eDeclare






#### STA: eDeclare — Declaration Header

The export declaration will have a new MANDATORY field requesting declarants to declare if the goods being exported are under Strategic Trade Act 2010 as below:




# The declarant MUST select Yes or No. If the declarant select YES, the system will require that the Permit Number be keyed-in.




#### The STA Permit No. is required to be keyed-in at the Supporting Document as shown.

- i) K2 Choose Code 817 (STA Export)
- ii) K8 Choose Code 818 (Export Transshipment) or 819 (Export Transit)
